Boscarel

50% Merlot, 35% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Sangiovese

This Bordeaux blend is named after the vineyard from which it is produced.

Tasting Notes:

Aromas of wild berries, specifically blueberry and raspberry, create an intense bouquet unhindered by oak aging. On the palate, it is full-bodied with a rounded mouthfeel and harmonious flavors. It is balanced by soft tannins and a lingering finish.

Pairs well with roasted and grilled red meats and hearty pasta dishes.

Vineyards:

Region: Veneto, Italy
Vineyard: Boscarel
Training Method: Spurred cordon
Planting Density: 5,000 vines/hectare
Soil Composition: Morainic & alluvial soil

Winemaking:

Harvest: Hand-harvested accordingly, due to multiple varieties
Fermentation: Each varietal is vinified separately, with maceration on skins for 15 days. Wine is blended and malolactic fermentation occurs

Aging:

6 months before bottling
