Goulart's flagship wine is produced from a small vineyard plot originally planted in 1905 by Marshall Gastao Goulart. It was restored to optimal conditions by current owner Erika Goulart, retaining many of the original roots. Now known as the Don Pedro vineyard, it was lovingly named after her eldest son.

Tasting Notes:

Aromas of black fruit, particularly black currants and plums, are highly concentrated, yet still very fresh. They are backed by well-integrated smokey oak undertones. Juicy on the palate, this Malbec is bursting with energy and purity of fruit.

Decanting is recommended before serving with hearty meat dishes.

Harvest: Hand-harvested in late April
Fermentation: Following a 72 hour cold soak, the wine was left on the skins for 32 days in stainless steel tanks, undergoing 100% malolactic fermentation
